## Intersession courses are -

- One-week or two-week undergraduate courses.
- One-credit (700 minutes) or two-credit (1,400 minutes) courses.
- Focused on experiential learning, skill-building, and/or topics that may not be taught in fall and spring semesters.
- Sponsored by Hopkins KSAS and WSE departments.
- Covered by tuition (no fee for current undergrad students).
- Taught in January, ahead of the spring semester.
- Taught by faculty, postdoctoral fellows, visiting fellows, and graduate students.
- Taught in person on the Homewood Campus or synchronously online.
- Graded as satisfactory (S) and unsatisfactory (U).
